We have continued to make revisions to our processes to ensure more accurate information and want to encourage you to download the app to better track and stay informed regarding our buses.

Here Comes the Bus® allows you to view the real-time location of your student's school bus on your smartphone, tablet, or computer. With it, you will have the information you need regarding the location of your student's school bus. In addition, you'll have peace of mind knowing your student has not missed the bus.

Here Comes the Bus® enables you to:

- See the location of your student's bus both before and after school.
- Confirm that your student's bus has arrived at the bus stop, at school or both.
- Receive a push notification or email message when the bus is near your stop, has been substituted, or when Warren Woods Public Schools has important information to relay.

Here Comes the Bus® is powered by Synovia Solutions™, makers of the GPS-tracking technology, created to increase safety and efficiencies as it relates to Warren Woods Public Schools bus fleet. The *Here Comes the Bus*® app can be downloaded from the App Store or Google Play.
