- 3** Home - Click the Schoology logo to come back to the Home Screen.
- 4** Courses - Click courses to see a card-based menu of the courses you are enrolled in.
- 5** Groups - Click groups to see a card-based menu of the groups you are enrolled in.
- 6** Resources - Click resources to view your resource center with anything you have saved.
- 7** Grades - Click grades to view a grade report for each of your courses as well as attendance.

Home Screen Overview

Elementary

- ▶ The Course Dashboard enables you to view all your courses as a tiled list. From the Course Dashboard, **click on the class with your grade level and AM in the title**. You may also see a custom picture that your teacher added. You can also click and drag course tiles to reorder them.



Locating Coursework



- ▶ Coursework will be located in the **Materials** tab on the left menu bar. Once you're in the **Materials** section of the course you can navigate through the course by selecting the appropriate folder.

Notifications

- ▶ Notifications display course events in chronological order as well as Requests to RSVP calendar events. New notifications/requests are indicated by a number on the bell icon. Clicking a notification or request will allow you to view the related content.



Using the Mobil App - iOS app

- ▶ Log In
 - ▶ Once you have an account, download the Schoology app from the Apple App Store. Tap the app icon to open it on your device.
- ▶ Steps:
 1. Use the keyboard to select **Warren Woods Public Schools**. As you type, matching choices populate in the list. The name, ID number, city, state, and zip code for the school should appear below.
 2. Select **Warren Woods Public Schools**.
 3. You can use your student's username to log in to the application.
 4. Tap **Log In** to complete.

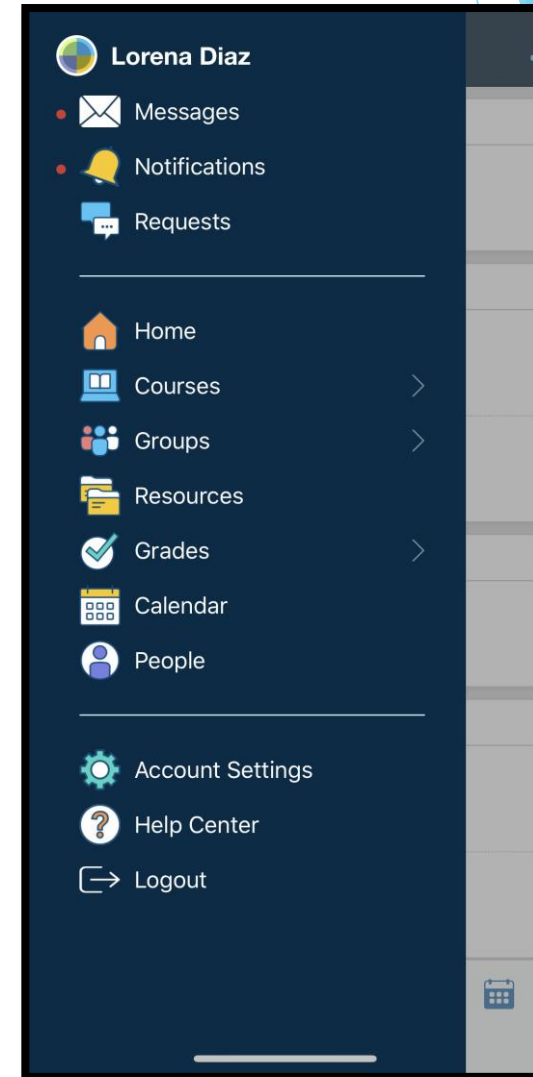

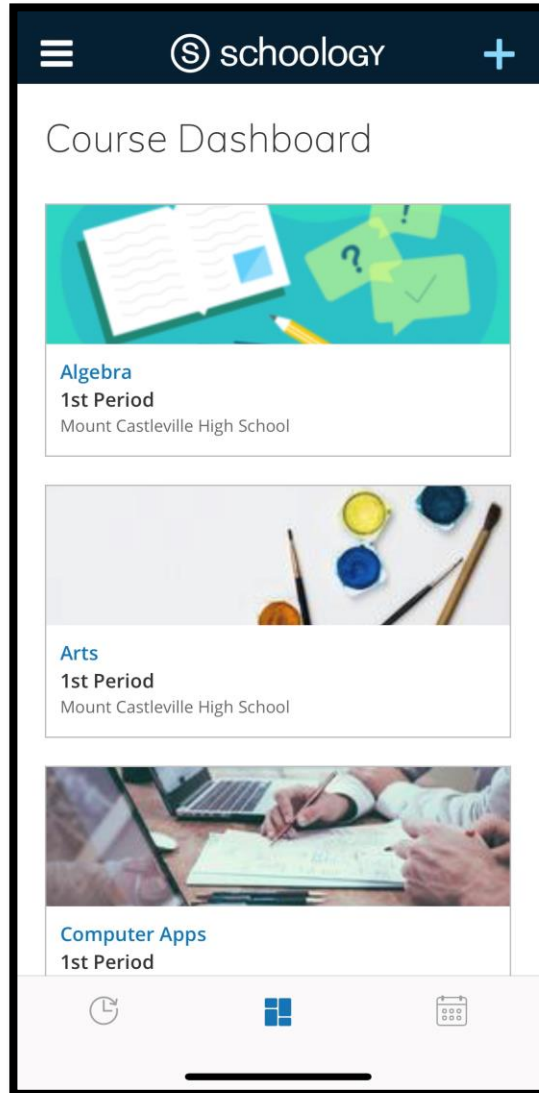
Navigation Window

- ▶ The Schoology iPhone app navigation menu allows you to quickly navigate to each essential location on the Schoology App. Tapping the navigation menu in the top left corner of the screen gives you immediate access to:
 - ▶ Your profile (tap your name)
 - ▶ Messages
 - ▶ Notifications
 - ▶ Requests
 - ▶ Home
 - ▶ Courses
 - ▶ Groups
 - ▶ Resources
 - ▶ Grades
 - ▶ Calendar
 - ▶ People
 - ▶ Account Settings
 - ▶ Logout

This navigation menu is available on every page so that you can quickly navigate through the app from any point.



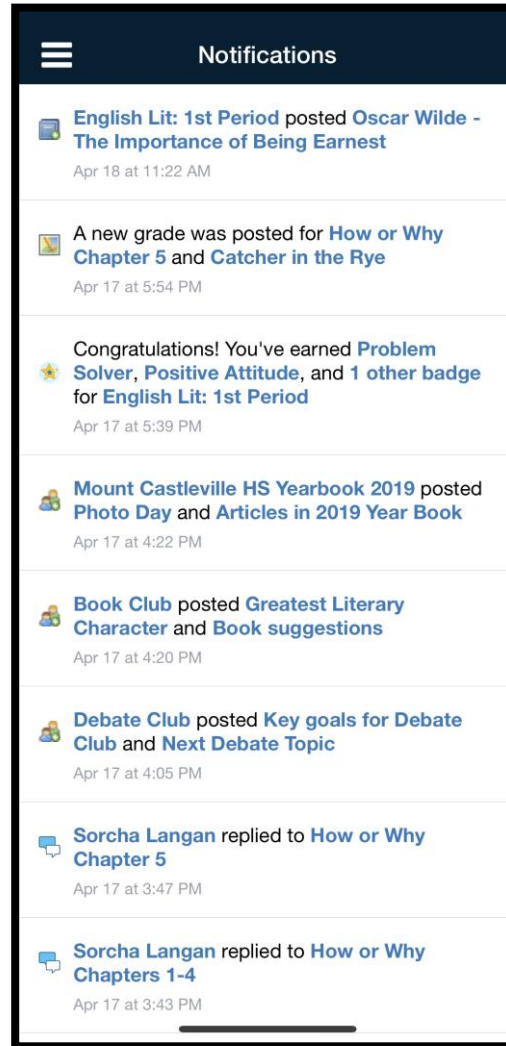
Mobile App Course Dashboard



- ▶ The Course Dashboard displays all your courses in a tiled list. You can access the Course Dashboard by tapping the tiled icon at the bottom of the **Home** screen.
- ▶ For elementary students: Please note you're likely to only see one or two courses.

Mobile iOS App: Notifications

- ▶ The menu notifications display course and group events in chronological order to keep you informed of Schoology activity. If you see a red dot next to **Notifications** in the navigation menu that means you have a new notification.




Mobile iOS App: Course Materials



- ▶ The **Materials** area lists all of the Assignments, Assessments, Tests/Quizzes, Files/Links, Discussions and Pages in a particular course. To view any of the materials just tap the name of the item.

Mobile iOS App: How to Submit an Assignment

After you've reviewed the assignment, the Schoology iOS app offers several ways to create and turn it in.

1. Open the assignment and tap **Submissions**.
2. Tap the + in the upper right corner and then tap:
 - ▶ **Create Submission** to write a text-only response. Tap **Save Draft** to save a working copy of the assignment, or the green checkmark  to submit.

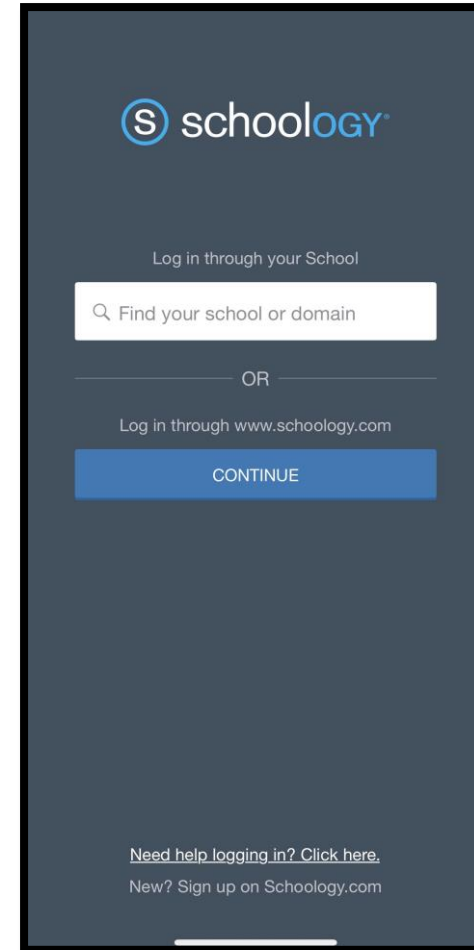
- ▶ **Submit Photo/Video** to add a file from your iPhone or iPad's camera roll

Using the Mobil App - Android app

▶ Log In

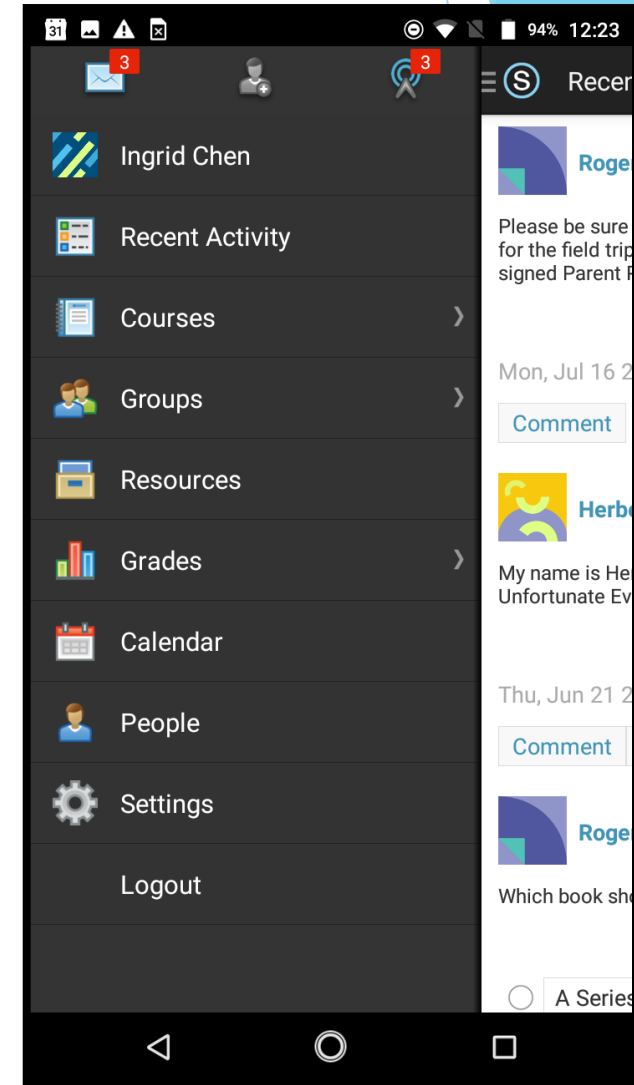
▶ Steps:

1. Use the keyboard to enter the name of your school or organization. As you type, matching choices populate in the list. The name, ID number, city, state, and zip code for the school should appear below.
2. Tap the name of your school or organization when it displays.
3. You can use an email address or username to log in to the application, depending on how your account was set up.
4. Tap **Log In** to complete.



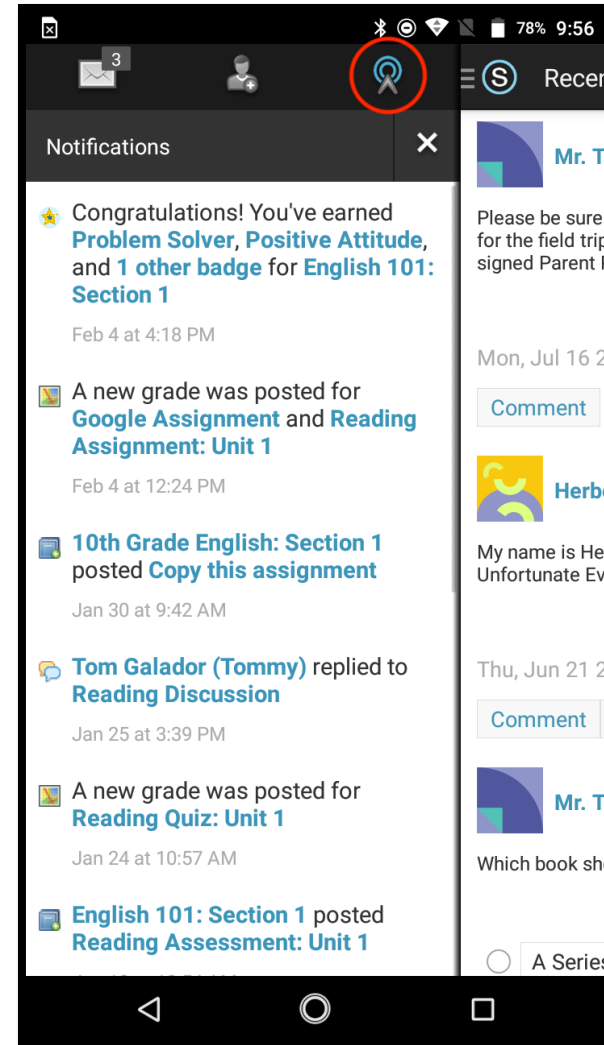
Mobile Device: Android - Navigation Window

- ▶ To access the areas of Schoology within the Android App, tap the Schoology icon at the top left of the screen to access the menu.
- ▶ From the navigation menu, you will be able to access:
 - ▶ Your Profile
 - ▶ Recent Activity
 - ▶ Courses
 - ▶ Groups
 - ▶ Resources
 - ▶ Grades
 - ▶ Calendar
 - ▶ People
 - ▶ Settings
 - ▶ Logout



Mobile Android: Notifications

- ▶ Schoology sends you email notifications for Social, Academic, Group, and School activity that occurs in your account. If you see a red dot next to Notifications in the navigation menu that means you have a new notification!



Mobile Android: How to Submit an Assignment

To make a submission to an assignment from the Android application, students can:

- ▶ Tap the assignment for which they'd like to make a submission.
- ▶ Swipe left to access the **Grades/Submissions** area, or tap the downfacing arrow in the header and select **Grades/Submissions**.
- ▶ Tap the + icon on the top right.
- ▶ To upload a submission from the device, select the option to **Upload Submission**. To create the submission from the application, select the option to **Create Text Submission**.
- ▶ To save a created submission as a draft, check the **Draft** box.
- ▶ Tap the arrow in the top right to complete.



Trouble Shooting Login Issues

- ▶ Make sure you're using the correct WARREN WOODS SCHOOLOGY Site
- ▶ <https://warrenwoods.schoology.com/>
 - ▶ Use your issued Username and Password. For students it typically is your first initial, last name, and unique numbers (*This was sent to you by the district*).
 - ▶ If you need your login information, message your child's teacher or building principal.
