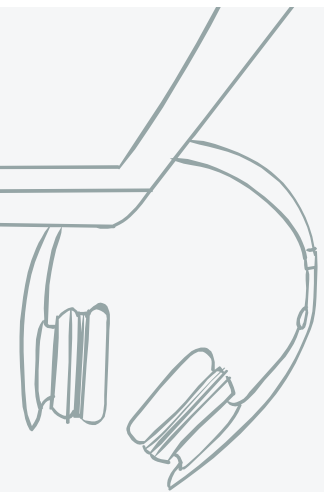
EAGLE LIBRARY EXPANSION

As the library continues to grow, thanks to your generous donations, Ms. Smith has begun cataloging the books on an app that students can use to find books that match their interest.






SUPPLEMENTAL INSTRUCTIONAL TIME

Purpose

- ✘ To provide students with Tier 2 intervention during the school day.
- ✘ On selected Wednesdays students visit teachers as needed for a 42 minute intervention block to receive one on one help.

Outcomes

- ✘ EHS has seen a dramatic increase in passing grades since the waiver started, from 63% in 2011-2012 to 84.5% in 2016-2017.
- ✘ Passing grades increased to 88% in the 2017-2018 school year!



Teachers monitor students' grades and identify who they need to see for intervention on a spreadsheet shared with all teachers.

Positive Behavior Intervention and Support

The School Improvement team added an additional positive behavior intervention this year with the goal of improving attendance. Students who maintain an 85% class grade or higher, five or less absences, three or less tardies, and no more than three write ups and no suspensions may opt out of taking their quarter exam. Several students strived for this and achieved in Quarter Three and Four! We are proud of their efforts!

Mr. Hughes provides one-on-one instruction for students who need extra help and guidance.



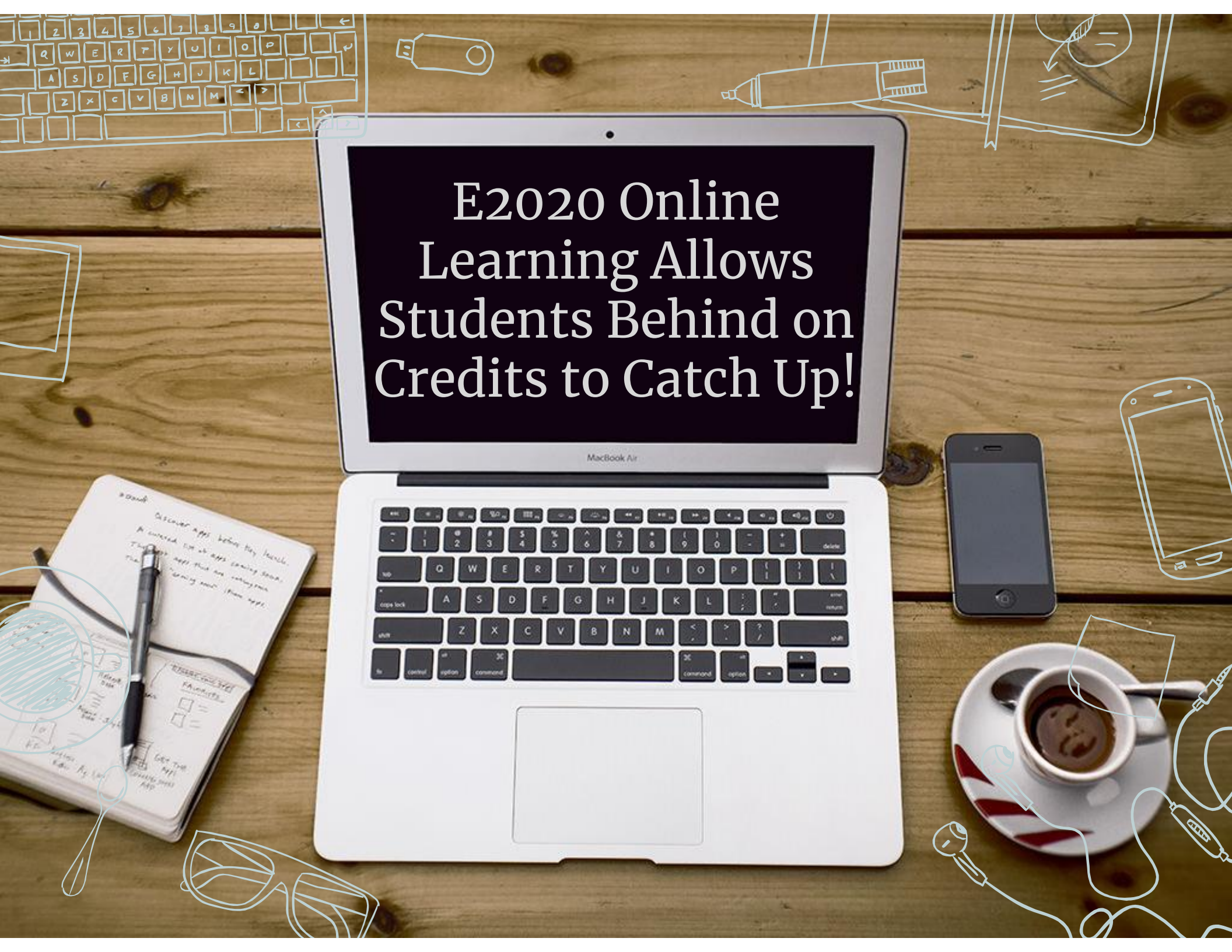

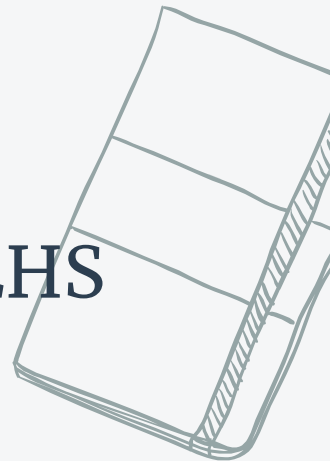
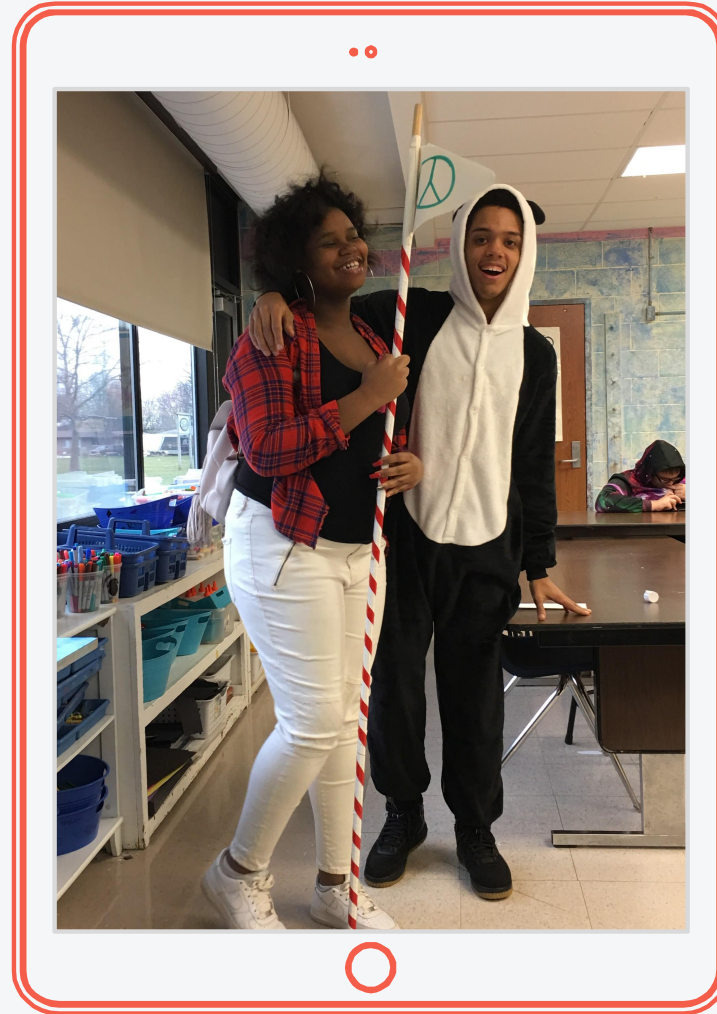

E2020 Online Learning Allows Students Behind on Credits to Catch Up!



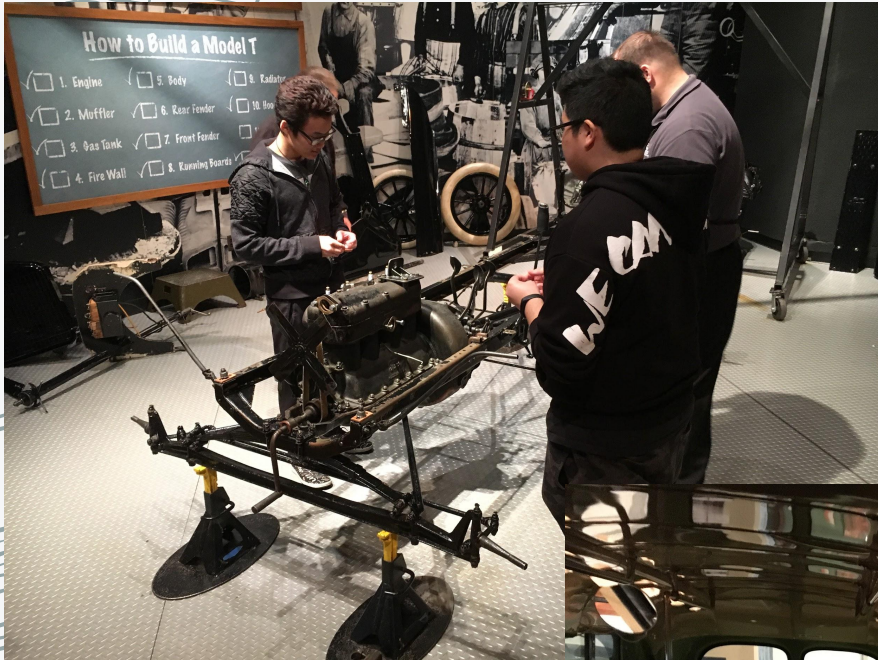


SPIRIT DAY

Throughout the year students show their EHS spirit by dressing up. Spirit Days are organized by a group of students.



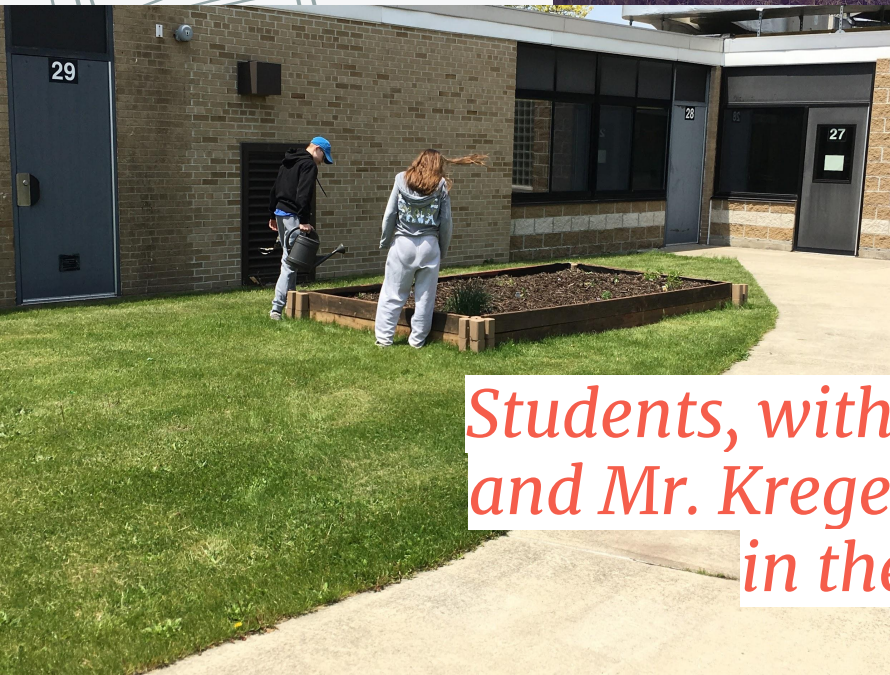

EHS Butterfly Garden

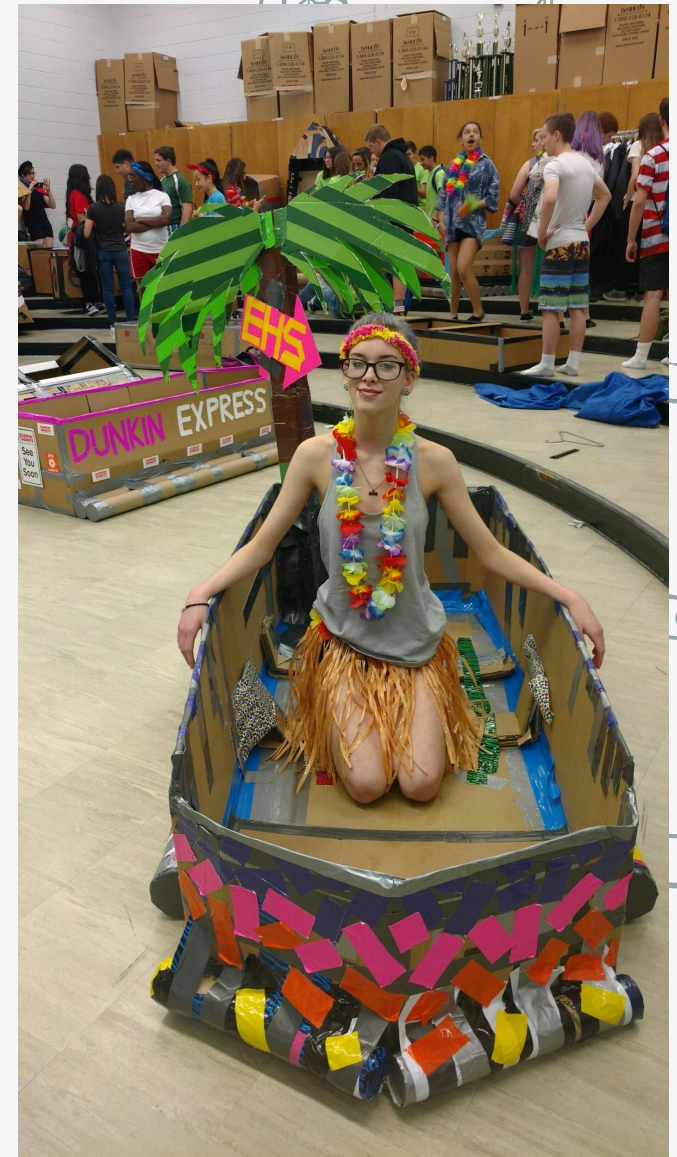


Students, with the help of Mrs. Jennings and Mr. Kreger, built a butterfly garden in the EHS courtyard.
