Warren Woods Enterprise High School Coordinator, Mr. George Hamblin, is proud to announce that there were 40 total high school graduates from Enterprise High School (EHS) in June, 2019. The EHS eight-year average (2012—2019) number of graduates is now at 45 students per year.

Three EHS students received EHS scholarships for their books and tuition for college in the fall. Scholarship winners were BriAnna Sims, Kiera Sweden, and Logan VanAssche. In addition, Yuridia Dang received special recognition and an art award from Mrs. Stasinski for her outstanding effort in art classes. Also, Mrs. Jennings, who retired at the end of the 2018-2019 school year, awarded the Jennings’ Scholarships to Rocky Rhoades and Cecilia Porter.

EHS counselor, Mr. Jason Nostrant, continues to lead the EHS commitment to helping students find career and educational opportunities after graduation. Also, Mrs. Cooper, Special Services Coordinator, continues expanding programs including the Michigan Rehabilitation Services and beyond. Moreover, Ms. Smith invited the University of Michigan’s Project Lighthouse to EHS, and several students went on a tour that included an orientation at the U of M. In addition, Mrs. Stasinski and Mr. Nostrant took students to the Detroit Institute of Arts in May.

Finally, Mrs. Jennings’s science students entered the Tower boat regatta contest. This year, EHS finished in first place after a second place finish last year.

THE STAFF AT EHS CONTINUES TO BE ENCOURAGED BY THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS THAT COMPLETED THEIR GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS. THE 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR SAW FORTY STUDENTS GRADUATE WITH HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMAS.

EHS STUDENTS AGAIN HAD TO PREPARE FOR AND TAKE A VARIETY OF STANDARDIZED TESTS. THE EHS SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT TEAM, LED BY MR. KREGER, MS. SMITH, MR. NOSTRANT, AND MRS. COOPER, GUIDED STUDENTS THROUGH THE SAT AND ACT WORK KEYS TESTS IN APRIL ALONG WITH THE STATE MANDATED M-STEP TESTING. OTHER FORMAL ASSESSMENTS THAT WERE USED TO GAUGE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT WERE THE NWEA TESTS IN THE FALL AND SPRING, THE PSAT TEST FOR TENTH GRADERS, AND THE PSAT AND SAT REVIEW TESTS IN DECEMBER.
