The Till Card

Many vendors are becoming (or already are) cashless. This affects our cash allowance meals, as well as the ability to purchase souvenirs since cash is no longer accepted everywhere we travel. To help solve this problem, Student Adventures will be using Till Cards to issue funds for cash allowance meals, rather than physical bills.

We **STRONGLY** recommend signing up for the Till Card, this will ensure your child will have a payment method for dining!!

Students who Register for a Till Card

- Students should sign up well in advance to allow time for their Till Card to arrive in the mail.
- Parents can ADD money to the card at any time to be used for souvenirs and snacks.
- Student Adventures will link your student's card to the trip and will send your student's lunch or dinner allowance directly to the card prior to the meal.
- The student keeps this card after the trip and students can continue to use it.

Students that DO NOT sign up for a Till Card

- Students that do not have a Till Card will receive a Loaner Card during the trip. Any parent on the trip will receive a Loaner Card because Till is only a product for minors.
- Student Adventures will send your student's lunch or dinner allowance directly to the Loaner Card prior to each meal.
- If your student doesn't use the entire amount for their meal, the remaining balance is theirs to keep/spend on other purchases while on the trip.
- Loaner Cards must be returned to the bus leaders after the final meal.

Washington DC Eligibility/Behavior Contract

Your child has the opportunity to attend an educational and exciting field trip to Washington DC. Because appropriate behavior is essential on all field trips, students must meet the following criteria to be eligible.

- If a student receives 2 or more "Ds" or 1 or more "Fs" on an 8th grade report card, he/she will be placed on academic probation. This means he/she is still eligible to go on the trip and payments can still be made. If the student does not improve these grades by the middle of 3rd quarter, he/she will be ineligible for the trip.
 - This does not apply to students who are showing their best effort and receiving low grades, based on teacher reports.
- If a student receives 2 or more "N"s or 1 or more "U"s in citizenship on an 8th grade report card, he/she will be placed on behavior probation. If the student does not improve these marks by the middle of 3rd quarter, he/she will be ineligible for the trip.
- If a student receives 3 or more office referrals or 4 or more classroom referrals, he/she will need to meet to discuss the situation, and may be ineligible for the trip.
- If a student has been suspended for any reason, at any time during 8th grade, he/she will be ineligible for the trip.
- Any unpaid fees to the school will need to be taken care of before the trip or he/she will be unable to attend.
- If a student has excessive unexcused absences and/or tardies in 8th grade he/she will be placed on probation. If there is no improvement by the middle of the 3rd quarter, he/she will be ineligible.
- **Teachers and administrators reserve the right to determine a student's final eligibility for trip participation.**

✧ ***Any student who falls under the criteria above has the right to an appeal.***
